

Adams County popular for destination weddings

Hauser Hill Event Center was featured in an article highlighting five destination wedding locations in Adams County published on the *Gettysburg Connection* website July 29, 2021.

"Another scenic outdoor venue is the Hauser Hill Event Center. It began as the Hauser Estate Winery which hosted weddings but remained open to the public. It has since rebranded to the Hauser Hill Event Center and is only open for weddings and private events.

"It is such a beautiful property for weddings with stunning views in every direction," said Event Coordinator Mindi Wood. "If they want an outdoor ceremony, we have a deck and a terrace for outdoor seating. Using tents, people can also enjoy the gorgeous views and be outside for the reception."

Wood, a former wedding photographer with 25 years of photography experience and 30 years of wedding planning experience, has an eye for detail that she believes is helpful for events. "It is important to me that every detail is carried out and that the day goes smoothly. I care about people and I want them to just enjoy the day and not have to worry about anything," said Wood.

"Hauser Hill is so beautifully decorated inside and outside that the couples really do not need to do much except show up, and that is my goal," said Wood. "We also are very flexible with the table arrangement, times for the events, and we are handicap accessible and dog friendly."
